1) Introduction

Founded in 1906, The Chartered Institute of Plumbing & Heating Engineering (CIPHE) is the plumbing and heating industry's professional body with around 11,000 members and an active overseas membership.

Registered educational charity status ensures that the Institute has as its principal aim the improvement of plumbing standards for the benefit of the community as a whole. To this end, all of its members are qualified and experienced. A Continuing Professional Development (CPD) programme encourages members to keep up-to-date with the latest in plumbing and heating technology and legislation.

As part of its service to the public, the Institute has a website, www.ciphe.org.uk which gives information about the Institute, its aims and activities.

Ultimately, the Institute's strength lies in its members who voluntarily undertake to perform with competence and commitment whilst at work. Membership of the CIPHE confers status within the industry while indicating a willingness to support high standards in plumbing and heating as an important contribution to public health and safety.

2) The Journeyman Plumber Certificate

The Livery Companies Skills Council (LCSC) and the CIPHE recognised the need for a Certificate to mark the commitment of Associates (ACIPHE) or Members (MCIPHE) who have attained S/NVQ Level 3 or equivalent in their chosen profession as a step beyond the Apprentice Plumber Certificate towards mastery of the art, craft, science and practice of plumbing.

Following submission of all relevant documents, including independent references, successful applicants will receive a Journeyman Plumber Certificate carrying the signatures of the President of the CIPHE, Master of The Worshipful Company of Plumbers and Chairman of the City & Guilds of London Institute.

3) Who can apply?

Any Chartered Institute of Plumbing & Heating Engineering Associate (ACIPHE) or Member (MCIPHE) who meets the criteria listed in 4) and intends to pursue career development with the objective of achieving Master Plumber Certificate status.

4) Requirements to satisfy conditions for the Journeyman Plumber Certificate

In order to apply for the Journeyman Plumber Certificate the following minimum requirements must be met and necessary evidence provided to support the application:-

- (a) be qualified to City & Guilds Ordinary Level / S/NVQ Level 3 or equivalent;
- (b) be an Associate (ACIPHE) or Member (MCIPHE) of the CIPHE;
- (c) recognise that while in membership of the CIPHE, the holder of a Journeyman Plumber Certificate is obliged to conform to the Institute's Code of Professional Standards;
- (d) copies of academic or other certificates must be submitted as evidence of qualifications;
- (e) there shall be no significant complaints on the applicant's Institute record;
- (f) the applicant shall provide evidence of employment in a formal Apprenticeship or written, verified statements of workplace experience as required for the award of S/NVQ Level 3 in Plumbing;
- (g) the applicant shall have been engaged in the plumbing industry for a minimum of four years;
- (h) the Journeyman Plumber Certificate is valid while the holder remains in membership of The Chartered Institute of Plumbing & Heating Engineering;
- (i) two nominated referees must sign the application. They should be people who know the applicant professionally, e.g. manager, teacher, etc;
- (j) the completed application must satisfy the panel of assessors;
- (k) submissions must include a cheque for £20, payable to CIPHE. This is a one-off payment as a contribution towards administration.
